For Jackson, Macon, and Swain County First-Year College Students

The Jackson, Macon, and Swain Counties Cattleman's Association was established in February of 2000. The purpose of the Association is to promote livestock and agricultural interests in Jackson, Macon, and Swain counties. In order to further this purpose the Association will offer up to three \$500 scholarships to aid **first-year** College students enrolled in livestock, agriculture, or forestry-related studies. The Association may award these three scholarships of \$500 per year to any student within the three county areas. Students entering college to study animal science, livestock production, agriculture education, or veterinary medicine will be given priority. Students entering any agricultural or forestry related field of study which includes *General Education* transfer courses into these fields will be prioritized next in order, all other fields of study will receive consideration. These scholarships may be considered for renewal. The Scholarship is derived from association funds and donations specified for educational purposes. **All sections of the application must be completed.** Failure to complete all components will render the application ineligible.

Applications and supporting letters and documents must be postmarked by **April 28th** by the date required.
